## Overview

He served as Chief Publications Editor of the Campbell Law Review and as Attorney General of the Campbell Honor Court, and received Book Awards in Constitutional Law II, Antitrust, and Pretrial Litigation. He is a member of the North Carolina Bar Association, the Tenth Judicial District Bar, and the Wake County Bar Association.
