

- Successfully defended a private North Carolina University and it's Director of Security in a wrongful death case involving alleged hazing and obtained a dismissal with prejudice pursuant to Rule 12(b)(6) on behalf of both clients. The dismissal was affirmed by the NC Court of Appeals and Discretionary Review was denied by the NC Supreme Court.
- Successfully defended a manufacturer of a pulse oximeter against allegations of product defect in a wrongful death case resulting in a favorable settlement for the client.

- Successfully defended a retail department store in a case involving an alleged brain injury in a child who was alleged to have been struck in the head by a piece of shelving. The case settled prior to jury selection for less than 6% of the original demand to settle the case.
- Successfully defended a large motion control and automation manufacturer in two of the largest civil law suits ever filed in North Carolina, involving catastrophic explosions at the West Pharmaceutical and ConAgra manufacturing plants. Both cases involved multiple wrongful death and catastrophic injury claims. In each case was able to establish that there was no viable theory of liability against the client, resulting in very nominal settlements in both cases.
